



1. PUBLISH YOUR FIRST PAPERBACK BOOK

1.1. Paperback Book Setup

- (Note) The process is very similar to the Kindle book's publishing, the main differences will be:
 - Cover design
 - PDF manuscript
- On the main page of KDP click on "Paperback"



- Select the book's language


- Book Title is the main title of the book

- Subtitle is a little bit trickier. Currently the mainstream naming is to add a descriptive “A Children’s book”, “A Juvenile Fiction” as a subtitle

- **(Tip)** The title and subtitle of the book are essential part of the Amazon SEO. Which means Amazon primary checks your title for keywords. This is a good and bad thing, since usually book titles are creative, and less descriptive. What we can do here is to reach a win-win situation is the following:
 - Use Book Title as normal, imagine the perfect title for the book
 - Use Subtitle for SEO like “A Children’s Picture Book with Moral”, “An Enchanting Kids Unicorn Book” or “An Educative Science Book for Kids” (Try to put the **target audience** and the **primary category** of the book in the Subtitle)

Series If your book is part of a series, add series details so readers can easily find the titles on a single detail page. (Optional) [Learn more](#)

Add your title to an existing series or create a new one. Linked formats for this title will be automatically added to the series once setup is complete.

- Here comes the option to add your book to an existing Series or Create a new one (If you didn't create one you can also go back to 2.1 just don't forget to Save the current process at the bottom with "Save as Draft", I prefer this option)

- You can add edition number if you republish your book ("2"). There is no need to add anything into this field if this is a new book
- The next field is the author name, the author name is primary your penname (in case of fiction) or your full name (in case if non-fiction), this will appear under your book's title and the public will see this name in every case they hold your book

Author Your paperback should have at least one author or primary contributor.

- You can add co-authors, illustrators, editors and other people who are contributing value to your book

Contributors You can add additional contributors including more authors, illustrators, editors, and translators, among others.

- (Tip) If anything goes wrong, do not worry, you can later edit this part **even after you published the book**, as a matter of fact I strongly recommend, to check the listing and come back to here once the book is live on Amazon. You simply make changes than “Re-Publish” the book (changes will take effect in 24 hours)



Keywords: This is a rather important field. You need to use all of the 7 fields. 7 keywords are not too much at all. First, you need to figure out the main category of your children's book

- Is it about magical creatures, animals, real life story, family story, fantasy

- ISBN: Amazon is able to provide a [free ISBN](#) to your paperback book, it's biggest hijack, that you can't use it to publish your book with another publisher or publishing platform. In other words it couldn't be used outside of Amazon. It seems to be a high restrictions, but in case of paperback books if you are focusing on English marketplace most likely you will sell 90% of paperback books on Amazon anyway. If you are planning wider distribution you can get a [paid ISBN](#) that could be used also for KDP paperback



- [Bleed Settings](#): If you want to print a book with a Bleed image (usually this is the case in children’s books), you need to select “Bleed”. In other ways any image will have space between the corners of the image and the page
- Cover finish: Select your preference
 - (Note) Glossy cover is more suitable for fiction titles, but trends are showing that they are less popular in 2021



Manuscript

Upload a manuscript of your book interior content. For best results, we recommend using a formatted PDF file to create your book. You can also upload a DOC (.doc), DOCX (.docx), HTML (.html), or RTF (.rtf). Hebrew, Latin, and Yiddish only support PDF manuscripts. Upload paperback manuscript

- Manuscript: This is the place where you can upload your print ready book manuscript
 - Use KDP's own [word templates](#) (in case of chapter books, in a picture books they are worthless)
 - Check Trim sizes to match with the above selected one, before any book formatting
 - There are a huge number of word editors out on the market, there is no single recommendation on our side, you can either use Microsoft Word (chapter books), Adobe InDesign (picture books) to prepare your book
 - **(Tip)** Always export the final manuscript into **PDF** and upload the PDF to KDP (other formats will have always problems when Amazon will process the file into a final print ready document)
 - If you aren't into formatting and want to outsource this task. Prepare a word document with the illustrations and final text (the pages should be matching exactly as it should be in the book) and send all the high-quality image source files to an editor.

- Cover: Maybe one of the most important part of your book. **Never**, I mean literally never use “Cover Creator” for your book.
- (Note) Cover creation process is more complex than in case of a Kindle cover, you will need to know the following information in order to create a paperback cover:
 - Exact trim size
 - Page numbers
 - Page thickness (usually it is white paper)
 - If you know all the above information you can [generate a cover template](#), this will help the designer/illustrator to produce an upload ready cover PDF as delivery
- (Note) You will need an ISBN barcode for your book (you can get one ISBN free from Amazon see above), that should be sent to your designer. Use [online barcode generator](#) to create your ISBN barcode image



- Pricing: In case of paperback books you have printing costs, that is calculate by the platform. At this point you will define the list price of your book that will be shown to the visitors
 - The most important factors that should define your book's price
 - Length of your book
 - Popularity of the author (if this is the first book of the author, keep the prices low)
 - Review count and editorial reviews (this counts in later stages, when your children's book already received feedbacks on Amazon)
 - As general I recommend the price cost plus \$2-3 at the beginning for a children's picture book
 - (Note) You can define paperback prices by marketplaces e.g., you can set different price for Amazon.co.uk (UK market)
 - **(Tip)** Enroll your book to Expanded Distribution, this is a great option to spread your book to wider audiences like other booksellers or libraries

It can take up to 72 hours for your book to be available for purchase on Amazon. Until then, the book's status will be "In Review" on your Bookshelf.

- **Publishing:** Usually the publishing process takes 24-72 hours, but if you change any attribute (like price) and re-publish your book it will take only several (7-24) hours and the changes will take place
- **(Tip)** Once you publish the book order an author copy instantly. Hence Amazon tries to show the end result to you during the setup process, in print it will be always different. After your book will be in hands, you will have the chance to make minor changes on the manuscript or cover before any marketing activity. We usually call this as soft launch.
